- DEC. 5 (1791) Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart dies in Vienna, Austria
- DEC. 6 (1966) The Beatles begin recording *Sgt. Pepper's Lonely Hearts Club Band*, ranked in 2003 by *Rolling Stone Magazine* as the greatest album of all time
- DEC. 8 (1947) Gregg Allman born in Daytona Beach, Florida
(1980) John Lennon is shot and killed in New York City
- DEC. 15 (1770) Ludwig van Beethoven born in Bonn, present-day Germany
(1944) Trombonist, bandleader and USAAF Maj. Glenn Miller's plane is lost over the English Channel during WWII
- DEC. 16 (1893) Dvořák's *New World Symphony* premieres at Carnegie Hall
- DEC. 18 (1892) *The Nutcracker* by Tchaikovsky premieres in St. Petersburg, Russia
- DEC. 22 (1858) Giacomo Puccini born in Lucca, Tuscany
- DEC. 24 (1871) Verdi's *Aida* premieres in Cairo
(1920) Tenor Enrico Caruso gives his last performance
