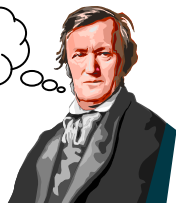

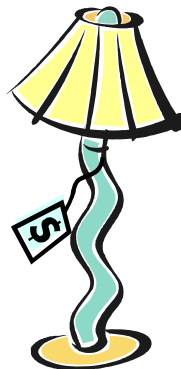

(1901) Violinist Jascha Heifetz born in Vilnius, Lithuania
- FEB. 3 (1959) Buddy Holly, Richie Valens and the Big Bopper are killed when their plane crashes near Mason City, Iowa
- FEB. 9 (1964) The Beatles appear on *The Ed Sullivan Show* for the first time—74 million viewers (nearly half the American population at the time) tune in to hear "I Wanna Hold Your Hand"
- FEB. 17 (1904) Puccini's *Madame Butterfly* premieres at La Scala in Milan, Italy
- FEB. 19 (1940) William "Smokey" Robinson born in Detroit, Michigan
- FEB. 22 (1956) Elvis Presley's first #1 single, *Heartbreak Hotel*, debuts on the charts
